WHEREAS, the Bay Area Regional Interoperable Communications System Authority (BayRICS) Board of Directors formally established a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) on August 11, 2011;

WHEREAS, the BayRICS Board appointed Steve Dupre as a charter member of the TAC to represent the San Francisco Bay Area, West Bay region;
