FirstNet was created by Title VI of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (PL112-96). The law includes provisions to fund and govern a nationwide public safety wireless broadband network, reallocate the 700 MHz D Block spectrum to public safety, and authorize the FCC to conduct incentive auctions to raise **\$7 billion** for building and managing the new network.



Why FirstNet?

FirstNet has been obligated by Congress to take all actions necessary to ensure the building, deployment and operation of the nationwide public safety broadband network.
