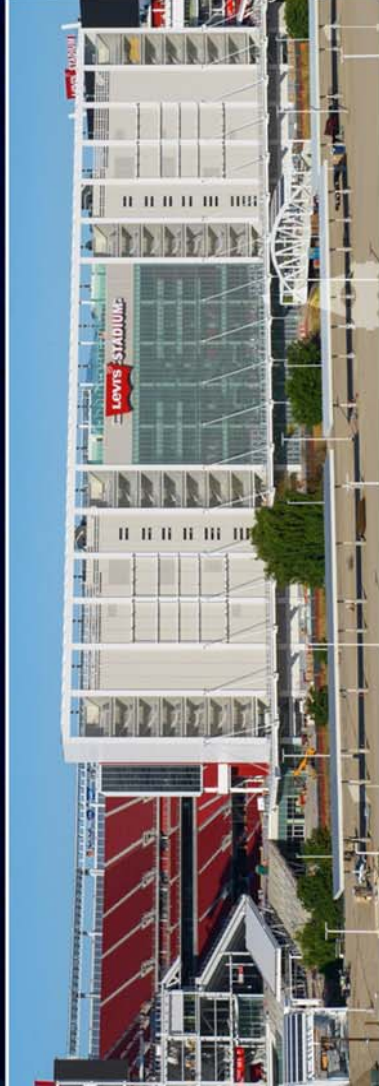


The Alameda County Sheriff's Office (ACSO) will host the 2015 Urban Shield Exercise, a planned training exercise involving local, national, and international first responder agencies. As part of the overarching exercise, Urban Shield's Yellow Area Command will facilitate a regional, functional and full-scale exercise (FSE) on Friday, September 11, 2015. The goal of the FSE is to engage Federal, State, and Local Emergency Operations Centers (EOCs) and promote coordination between jurisdictions including notification, communication, and on-scene response operations in response to a complex coordinated terrorist attack to the Bay Area Region.
